## **About the Arizona Wind Symphony: Its mission, scope of activities, and its impact**

**AWS Mission:** To create opportunities for lifelong musical expression, education, cultural enrichment and artistic-educational growth for its members, audience, and community. To explore and share the value of music and the arts through collaborative projects with regional and national guest artists.

**AWS Scope of Activities:** AWS is an Arizona non-profit corporation organized and operated for cultural purposes, primarily operating an adult concert band that performs at least on five occasions throughout the year (October through May).

**AWS Impact:** AWS continues to perform for large and diverse audiences. In the past two seasons, AWS has enjoyed record ticket sales and has experienced the most successful concert attendance on record since 2007, when AWS began its residency with Tempe Center for the Arts (TCA). Audiences are multi-generational in scope. Concert themes and repertoire include performing quality literature that comes from a diverse range of genres, from classical, to jazz, to contemporary. Furthermore, AWS impacts the community by collaborating with various performing artists. In 2024-2025, AWS collaborated with guest artists including Alto Saxophonist Jonathan Bergeron, Motown Artist Sandra Bassett, Phoenix Opera Quintet, Mariachi Osos del Valle, and the 108<sup>th</sup> Army Band – Front Line Jazz Combo. The 2025-2026 season will feature world-renowned artists during AWS's 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, including Clarinet Duo Josh and Stefanie Gardner, Trumpetist Joe Burgstaller, Pianist Cathal Breslin, and Tubist Patrick Sheridan.
